WHAT IS THE STRUCTURED DAY PROGRAM?

The Structured Day Program is grant funded which allows students who have been suspended from school to work on assignments and practice life skills and earn credit for attending school while in a safe and structured environment.

WHAT IS THE VOCATIONAL PROGRAM?

The Vocational Program is grant funded which assists with finding and maintaining employment. It includes, but is not limited to, resume building, interviewing and job retention skills.

OUR MISSION

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ On a participant's first day, an intake packet for the parent/guardian of the participant will need to be completed.
- ▶ School lunch will be provided but participants are welcome to bring their own lunch.
- ▶ Participant's teachers will be contacted for assignments will receive the projects once they have been completed.
- ▶ Participants work on assignments, which is tracked with an assignment sheet.
- ▶ Once a participant completes the program, they will complete a survey and a termination letter will be sent to their school.
- ▶ Participants who are disruptive, or pose a threat, will be suspended for the day or terminated from the program.
- ▶ **Full participation for current event and life skill lessons is required.**

REFERRALS

Referrals can be emailed to the program at structuredday@bgccp.com or brought in on the participant's first day. In order to best serve the participant, please provide as much information as possible. Examples: problem behaviors, brief description of the incident, previous suspension.

WHO CAN BE REFERRED?

- ▶ Full-time students of Carteret County in grades K-12
- ▶ Vocational Program must be between the ages of 14-18 years
- ▶ Short and long-term suspensions
- ▶ Former participants
- ▶ Students referred to teen or juvenile court

WHO CAN REFER?

- ▶ School or school resource officer (SRO)
- ▶ Parent or guardian
- ▶ Juvenile court counselor
- ▶ Teen or District court
- ▶ DSS
